Dear Parent/Carer

We would like to remind you of the arrangements when dropping off / collecting your children from school..

1. Access to the school site and driveway from the Pyghtle is strictly forbidden for parents, unless you have a pre-booked meeting with a member of staff. Please Do NOT drive on to the site, use our driveway or site entrance to turn vehicles or wait in visitor parking to collect or drop off children. This is for the protection of our student safety.
2. Pupils should be dropped off outside of the school site in the Pyghtle or Gold Street. It is not safe for cars to drop pupils off within 20 yards of the school entrance. Recently a pupil was struck by a car due to the sheer volume of traffic within the Pyghtle. Please recognise that our students have right of way as pedestrians when crossing roads.
3. We are concerned by the increasing incidents of road rage that occur within the Pyghtle each morning. If you choose to drive along the Pyghtle between 8.00am and 8.35am, please understand that your journey will be delayed significantly by the volume of traffic around the Pyghtle / Gold Street junction. It is recommended that you avoid this junction between these times.
4. We would like to remind parents to be respectful of the Academy's neighbouring community, ensuring the safety of our children is paramount. We kindly ask you not to park on yellow lines, zig zag lines or block residents driveways with your vehicles.

The Academy will continue to work closely with Northamptonshire Police to do all we can to eliminate accidents and incidents outside of our school site. Please play your part in this by respecting the school's rules and the highway code.
