## **Reward Systems**

Sir Christopher Hatton Academy uses positive methods and systems to improve student's behaviour and standards of work. Through the rewards system staff can encourage and reinforce good behaviour and attributes. This system focuses on the positive rather than sanction methods.

## **Rewards**

The pupils are rewarded in different ways at school. Firstly, the class teacher can reward good work, attitude, behaviour etc. on a lesson by lesson basis by using the Vivo system. This can also be highlighted in class at the time, in their book or by contacting home via phone or letter. Another reward is for participation in extra-curricular clubs or House competitions. Each week the pupils are awarded Vivos for both 100% attendance and punctuality. The final reward category occurs when the attitude and behaviour in school reports is rewarded with Vivos.

## **House System**

We have a House System for all members of the school, including staff. Termly House assemblies are held to inform pupils of the MVP winners and House Cup winners. The House Cup is awarded to the House that is awarded the most Vivos during one term. Each student can access the details of Vivo scores on FROG, the in school VLE to see how many Vivos they have received throughout the year. All pupils and parents can see daily how they are earning their rewards and which staff members are awarding the Vivos. All pupils are informed of how the system works at the start of year in DOY assemblies as well as during House assemblies each term. These Vivos continue to accumulate throughout the year for students to spend on rewards from the online Vivo shop.

## **MVP**

Each term the top two Vivo scoring pupils from each House are awarded the accolade of MVP. The pupils are invited to a lunch with the Heads or House and the Principal to celebrate their hard work and achievements. The pupils also receive a MVP medal, a photo and letter to celebrate their success.

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
