Will I get one of my choices?	Yes, if possible. Please don't be too disappointed if you do not receive one of your three choices, or if it is not the same as your friends, as some are more popular than others. A computer sort allocates your choice.
What if I don't choose 3 activities?	The computer sort will allocate your choice – so make sure you choose 3 options!
Do I have to pay?	 Most activities are free There may be a small charge for materials/resources/subscriptions Full payment is required in advance for activities via Sims Pay please use the payment reference given by the Finance Office No payment is required if you are eligible for free school meals however you must submit the online consent sent via MyEvolve our new online consent portal Please check with your parents first before selecting activities with a cost
