## RE: An Inspector Calls theatre performance – Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2020

We have an excellent opportunity for your child to take part in a theatre visit to the Milton Keynes Theatre, on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2010 at 2.30 pm. Students will be watching a performance of 'An Inspector Calls' by J.B Priestley.

This play will be extremely beneficial for your child as exposes them to a live performance of the GCSE literature text they will be studying; helping them to gain a greater insight to the narrative, characters and the social message of the playwright. Ultimately assisting them further in their understanding of the play overall.

Students will be leaving the school at 1pm sharp and returning at 6pm approximately, traffic permitting. Please make appropriate arrangements for your child to be collected at this time. If for some reason we are delayed due to traffic conditions students will be informed to text home to advise of estimated time of arrival however if your child does not have a mobile phone please indicate below. There is some remote supervision during the interval of the performance, students will be asked to move about the theatre in groups to use the facilities.

The cost for this visit is £24.50 this includes transport and a ticket to the play. Allocation for this visit is on a first come first served basis with the deadline to return forms and payment by Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2019 at the latest. For children eligible for free school meals, financial support maybe available for this activity. Please contact the school for more information.

For this visit school uniform is required as per the normal school day, including school shoes. The following is required for the visit

- > Small backpack/bag to carry items
- Lunch that will be eaten at school or money for lunch as normal
- A snack if required and drink
- > Small amount of pocket money for additional drinks etc
- Please leave all valuable items at home in case they become lost
- Mobile phones are to remain switched off/on silent during the visit and only used to inform of home time arrival as per any school day.
