Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to you following the Prime Minister's recent announcement, in which he outlined plans for the next stage in the national response to the Covid-19 pandemic. This was followed by more guidance for families and schools from the Department for Education on how the opening of schools may be extended in the coming weeks and months.

The government's aim is that secondary schools will begin with limited face to face support for Year 10 and 12 pupils at some point after the half term holiday. Clearly, there are many ways in which this can be achieved, and the precise nature of that support and contact with teachers now requires careful planning. We will write to the parents and carers of all Year 10/12 students later this month to set out the detail of the face to face provision that we will be able to offer when it has been agreed at a strategic level.
